Dear Mr. Barry:

This is a final response to your request for Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) records under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. § 552. Your request was received in our office on September 20, 2016, with an acknowledgement e-mail sent to you on October 3, 2016.

**You requested:**

“All copies of travel records, as required by Federal Travel Regulations, for all current, former and acting SES employees. To include: (a) transportation expenses as provided in Part 301-10; (b) per diem expenses as provided in Part 301-11; (c) miscellaneous expenses as provided in Part 301-12; and (d) travel expenses of an employee with special needs as provided in Part 301-13. As well as any special authorizations for: (a) use of other than coach-class service on common carrier transportation; (b) use of a foreign air carrier; (c) use of reduced fares for group or charter arrangements; (d) use of cash to pay for common carrier transportation; (e) use of extra-fare train service; (f) travel by ship; (g) use of a rental car; (h) use of a government aircraft; (i) payment of a reduced per diem rate; (j) payments of actual expense, unless your agency has issued a blanket actual expense authorization under §301-70.201; the records should include all submitted expenses, and detail which ones were approved and which ones were denied.”


**Response:**
