This communication serves as the Bonneville Power Administration's (BPA) final response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request BPA-2016-01251-F. Your request was received in this office on July 29, 2016, and acknowledged on August 15, 2016.

For each property, please provide issue dates, payee names, addresses, and dollar amounts due."

The appeal must contain all of the elements required by 10 C.F.R. § 1004.8, including a copy of the determination letter. Thereafter, judicial review will be available to you in the Federal District Court either: 1) in the district where you reside; 2) where you have your principal place of business; 3) where DOE's records are situated; or 4) in the District of Columbia.
