Dear Mr. Sickinger:

This is a final response to your request for records that you made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA), under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. 552.

You requested the following:

“A copy of any incident report or security video tape of Anita Decker's recent car crash off the loading dock in BPA's parking garage.”

Response:

BPA is releasing the enclosed documents with some information being redacted under Exemption 6 of the FOIA. The video request is being withheld in its entirety under Exemption 6.

BPA asserts this exemption for information which could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy if disclosed. The withheld information consists of the names of individual citizens involved in, and photos and video, of the above incident. There is no public interest in the disclosure of this information because it does not shed any light on how BPA has performed its statutory duties.

Pursuant to 10 CFR 1004.8, if you are dissatisfied with this determination, or the adequacy of the search, you may appeal in writing within 30 calendar days of receipt of a final response letter. The appeal should be made to the Director, Office of Hearings and Appeals, HG-1, Department of Energy, 1000 Independence Avenue, SW, Washington, DC 20585-1615. The written appeal, including the envelope, must clearly indicate that a FOIA Appeal is being made.

NARRATIVE



BPA Employee drove her vehicle off the loading dock at B1 BPA Headquarters.

At approximately 1245 I, Ex 6 RAMS security site supervisor at BPA HQ, was called to investigate an incident on the B1 level. HQ Post – 1 Ex 6 contacted and informed me that someone drove their vehicle off the loading dock at B1 level.

Upon arrival I observed a black Porsche Cayenne, OR license plate Ex 6 located in the middle of the two loading parking spots. I approached the driver who was identified as Anita Decker. I asked Mrs. Decker what happened. She stated, "I drove off the deck". Mrs. Decker appeared anxious and was visibly shaking. I asked Mrs. Decker if she want me to call an ambulance or in need of medical attention. She replied, "No". I asked Mrs. Decker if she had anybody else with her in the vehicle. She said, "No".

I then notified OSCO Ex 6 and Ex 6 Facilities Ex 6 and Ex 6 was also informed of the incident and responded to location. FPS was notified by Ex 6 where Ex 6 responded to location. Ex 6 of Personnel Security, Ex 6 from the Safety Office along with Ex 6 also arrived to the area.

Pictures of the vehicle were taken, its location and damages to the vehicle and loading dock.

Mrs. Decker contacted her AAA insurance company and arranged towing of the vehicle to the Ex 6 for damage assessment. At about 1430 AAA tow truck driver Ex 6 arrived and towed the vehicle.

Ex 6 arranged transportation for Mrs. Decker.

Collected video and images were provided to OSCO.
