To Parties Interested in Long-Term Regional Dialogue

On June 6, 2008, I sent a letter seeking comment on FY 2010 Existing Resource amounts to be used in Contract High Water Mark (CHWM) calculations. Since then BPA has had further discussions with Grays Harbor Public Utility District (Grays Harbor) that have raised the need for a change to this public comment period.

Grays Harbor has provided additional information to BPA that upon further review may lead to a decision by BPA that the Weyerhaeuser Pulp Mill should not be counted as a reduction against Grays Harbor when calculating its CHWM. Additionally, Grays Harbor has requested, and BPA has agreed, to shorten the comment period regarding this particular resource as Grays Harbor is attempting to make short term decisions on the future of this resource. To accommodate this request, BPA is asking that all comments on the Weyerhaeuser Pulp Mill be submitted by **June 20, 2008**.

Please note BPA is accepting comments on all other FY 2010 Existing Resources through close of business **June 27, 2008**.
