

Summary of Eligible TSRs for 2009 Network Open Season

As of 5 pm, Tuesday, June 30, 2009, Bonneville Power Administration's Transmission Services closed the window for customers to submit new long-term firm transmission service requests (TSR) for consideration in the 2009 Network Open Season (NOS). BPA has reviewed all TSRs, determined their eligibility and, for those eligible requests, will be tendering a Precedent Transmission Service Agreement (PTSA). The executed PTSA and its associated security requirement are due from customers by COB August 19, 2009.

This notice is to provide BPA customers with a breakdown of the eligible TSRs, based on those submitted for the 2009 NOS. Final participation in the 2009 NOS will not be known until after the August 19 deadline at which time BPA will post an updated summary.
