Deadline Extension for the Evaluation of Redirects on the BPA Network for Transmission Service Requests from 2008, 2009 and 2010 Network Open Seasons

To all interested parties,

BPA is extending the deadline of the April 1, 2011 notice to modify its ATC Methodology, originally effective April 1, 2011. That [notice](#) will now expire at 5 PM, PDT, May 31, 2013.

Transmission Services issued a notice to Network Open Season (NOS) participants for the removal of the Network Composite POD evaluation methodology through the 2008, 2009 and 2010 NOS Bulletins, effective April 1, 2011.

That notice provided an extension of the use of the Network Composite POD evaluation methodology for redirect requests among Network PODs for service confirmed or pending under a 2008, 2009 or 2010 PTSA.

Once the extension's deadline is reached, all Redirect Requests (whether or not the parent TSR was associated with a 2008, 2009, or 2010 PTSA) will be evaluated using the new Long-Term ATC Methodology [evaluation methodology](#).
