# History of Task Force Formation

- February 10, 2014:
  - NERC filed a petition in Docket No. RM14-7-000 proposing the retirement of several NERC MOD (ATC) standards due to their commercial nature.
  - NERC submitted a standards development request to NAESB to consider the development of standards that support NERC ATC standards proposed for retirement that may be relevant from a commercial or business perspective.
  
- February 18<sup>th</sup>, 2014
  - NAESB EC evaluated the NERC request
  - Assigned a Task Force to:
    1. Evaluate Request R14002 (NERC request to NAESB),
    2. Propose assignments for new or existing subcommittees of the WEQ EC, and
    3. Recommend a defined scope and timeline\* for the proposed assignments
  
- April 10<sup>th</sup>, 2014
  - EC Task Force kick-off meeting
  - Concluded with recognizing that a review of FERC directives was needed in addition to the NERC matrix
  
- June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2014 Task Force Meeting
  - review comments submitted by task force participants,
  - discuss next steps
  - potentially propose assignments to existing or new subcommittee.

\* An implementation date of 18 months from issuance of the FERC Final Order on the NERC petition has been proposed; however, NERC staff has committed to working with both NAESB and FERC staff to address any timing issues NAESB may encounter during the project

- Next EC Task Force Meeting, June 10<sup>th</sup>, 2014
- ATC is an OASIS standards setting issue
  - EC can assign to the OASIS Subcommittee
  - OS will strive to complete STCP standards drafting
- Ultimate assignment and project scope will be approved by the EC possibly in August
