



Transmission Services Standard Performance Metrics

Reporting period July 1, 2008 - September 30, 2008

The following metrics are reported in compliance with the Standard Performance Metrics required by Title 18 CFR, Part 37.6(h).

Performance Metrics

BPA Transmission Services completed no Study Agreements and issued no reports during the third quarter.

Between April 15, 2008, and June 15, 2008 BPA Transmission Services conducted its first Network Open Season for transmission paths internal to the network. During Network Open Season, Transmission Services offered Precedent Transmission Service Agreements (PTSA's) to all customers with transmission service requests (TSR's) already in the transmission queue and to all customers that submitted new TSR's between April 15, 2008 and May 15, 2008 for service over Bonneville's internal transmission network, a total of 153 requests. The Network Open Season excluded TSR's for service over the interties.

Transmission Services later determined that it had sufficient ATC for 47 of the TSR's submitted under the Network Open Season, and therefore offered or is in the process of offering transmission service under 47 PTSA's without the need for studies. Transmission Services is conducting a cluster study for the remaining 106 requests. The cluster study is scheduled to be completed on October 31, 2008.

TSR's submitted after May 15, 2008, for service over the internal network were added to the queue but have not been offered study [SIS] agreements. Transmission Services will offer PTSA's for these requests during the 2009 Network Open Season and will conduct a cluster study for these and all other TSR's that are submitted before the close of the 2009 Network Open Season, a date yet to be established.

During the Network Open Season, Transmission Services has not issued new SIS or SFS agreements or studies for external paths. Network Open Season guidelines and principles are being considered for these external paths as well.
