Standard Performance Metrics

Reporting period January 1, 2013 - March 31, 2013

The following metrics are reported in compliance with the Standard Performance Metrics required by Title 18 CFR, Part 37.6(h).

Performance Metrics

BPA Transmission Services did not execute any Study Agreements and issued no System Impact (SIS) or System Facility Study (SFS) reports during the first quarter of 2013. During this time, BPA did not have any staff processing SIS or SFS.

BPA has conducted three Network Open Seasons (NOS) in 2008, 2009 and 2010, processing requests for long-term transmission service. As a result, BPA has identified several major transmission expansion projects, which are currently in various states of construction or review.

BPA has made its decision with respect to the improvements and restart for the next NOS. BPA intends to conduct a Cluster Study beginning in September 2013, and is working to finalize the Form of Cluster Study Agreement for tender in mid-July. In addition, BPA is also working to make improvements to the Precedent Transmission Service Agreement that may govern transmission service for future transmission projects.
